# League of Women Voters of Washington County Proposed Program of Action 2021-22

## • Redistricting

- As Arkansas uses Census population results to redraw political boundaries, the League will work to promote a process to create fair maps that are drawn without political motivations.
- We will continue to work toward a more fair, independent redistricting process in the future.

#### • Voting Rights

The League will support efforts to ensure election access, defending against proposals that would limit access to voting locations or put unnecessary restrictions on absentee and mail-in voting.

## • Voter Registration

- The League will continue to hold voter registration events and to promote the importance of registration.
- We will support efforts to shed light on unnecessary purging of voter registration rolls.

#### Protecting the Initiative Process

- The League will oppose and call public attention to the legislative proposal to increase the threshold by which voter-initiated acts and constitutional amendments are approved.
- We will continue to advocate for robust protections of the petition signature-gathering process.

## • Ranked-Choice Voting

The League will promote efforts to replace our state's election system with one that would allow voters to rank the top candidates they support, in order of preference.

#### • Environmental Protection

The League will continue its longstanding research and advocacy on environmental issues in Northwest Arkansas.
